4. An Orientation cum Refresher Session on the Objectives, Structure, and Operations of the Institution's Innovation Council for IIC Institutions.
5. The speaker emphasized the importance of research, innovation, and entrepreneurship in India's education system and the challenges faced by institutions in promoting these areas.
6. The council focuses on six pillars: system development, leadership, structure, cultural development, and strategy.
7. The IIC is a crucial component in measuring institutional performance and provides opportunities for students and faculty to engage with industry partners and resources. The council also offers incentives, rewards, and recognition for selected innovations. The IIC portal offers various subprograms, such as Mentor Mentee Impact Lecture, and innovation entrepreneurship-related learning courses.

It was a well conducted session and enriched the participants with information on IIC. The IIC members of BVIMIT actively engaged in all sessions with a commitment

to revolutionizing support for innovation and creativity. They gained valuable insights on developing a robust mentorship framework, aiming to foster a more integrated educational environment.
