## Anti-ragging Policy AICTE Regulations as per the Directives of Supreme Court

**Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts:**

Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.

Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.

Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.

Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.

Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.

Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.

Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.

Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, posts, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.

Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

Every single incident of ragging a First Information Report (FIR) must be filed without exception by the institutional authorities with the local police authorities.

\*Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following:-

1. Suspension from attending classes
2. Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits

- 1) Certificate of passing of the qualifying examination (i.e. 10th, 12th, Degree mark sheet & passing certificate) with true copy of the statement of marks.
  - 2) College Leaving Certificate (After qualifying exam).
  - 3) Certificate of Date of Birth / Domicile Certificate.
  - 4) Caste Certificate & Validity (If applicable) issued by concerned authorities.
  - 5) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate.
  - 6) Adhar Card.
  - 7) Income Certificate.
- B) Copies of certificate attached to application form should be attested by the Head Master / Principal of School / Institute, or a Gazetted officer or Special Executive Magistrate. Original certificates, if attached to the application will not be returned.
- C) Application for admission will not be considered unless it is:
- 1) Properly & correctly filled in.
  - 2) Accompanied by attested copies of required certificates mentioned above.
  - 3) Received in the office by the proper authority on or before the last date prescribed.
- D) The application form of any of the certificated received after the last date prescribed shall not be entertained.

Institute level seats available on merit of MAH-MCA-CET.

For these seats the candidates after applying to the Competent Authority shall thereafter apply to the concerned institution for admission at Institution level and the Institution shall give admission on the basis of inter-se merit in the Merit List prepared by the Competent Authority. It is pre-requisite and mandatory to apply to the Competent Authority to be eligible for admission under this quota.

## Admission Procedure

The MCA course is affiliated to the University of Mumbai and approved by AICTE, New Delhi, recognized by Directorate of Technical Education and Govt. of Maharashtra with 6 semesters over three years with intake of 120 students a year.

### Eligibility

Candidate must have passed OR appeared for the final year examination with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (+5% in case of candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra State only) in any Full Time Bachelor's degree of minimum three years duration in any discipline recognized by the Association of Indian Universities and having studied Mathematics or Statistics as one of the subjects at 10+2 level or higher level examination are also eligible to apply.

### Selection Process

Candidate has to appear and qualify the common Entrance Test MAH-MCA-CET conducted by Government of Maharashtra State Common Entrance Test Cell.

- A candidate desirous of seeking admission through CAP should fulfil the eligibility criteria mentioned above.
- The candidate's name should figure in the concerned merit list (Respective University level/ State level General Merit list / OMS merit list / J&K Migrant Merit List) prepared for admission.
- The result of the MAH-MCA-CET will be displayed on the website: [www.dte.org.in/mca](http://www.dte.org.in/mca). It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to keep abreast of notifications displayed on the official website [www.dte.org.in/mca](http://www.dte.org.in/mca) from time to time and follow the instructions given therein.
- Seats will be allotted to candidate as per their inter se merit, as per the options filled in the online option form and the number of seats available at that point of time in the stage of CAP Rounds for admission will be conducted only for eligible Maharashtra State Candidates whose names have appeared in Maharashtra State Merit list.
